

Is breast augmentation something you have considered?

Communication with your plastic surgeon is important. Making the decision to have breast augmentation surgery is not to be taken lightly and you will have many questions. Initially you will need a cosmetic consultation with Mr Bialostocki that takes approximately 45 minutes.

During this consultation, advice on the procedure will be discussed, details about the surgery, aftercare and follow up explained. A screening mammogram needs to be scheduled, which Mr Bialostocki asks all women older than 35 years to have done prior to surgery.

From time to time the media raises issues about breast implants and their safety. Naturally, this type of information only emphasises risk and seldom addresses the great benefits that only women who have had augmentation or reconstruction can understand. It is accepted that women with implants, whether for augmentation or reconstruction, have no increased risk of breast cancer.

Mr Bialostocki only uses the best quality silicone implant available internationally. Choosing the right size and shape for an individual woman is an art and there are many options to select from. At your consultation, this will be discussed at length and your desired outcome taken into full consideration.
